

MEMBER AGENCIES & COMMITTEES

The Solano Transportation Authority (STA) was created under a Joint Powers Agreement in 1990 to serve as the Congestion Management Agency to program federal, state and regional transportation funds. STA member agencies include the cities of Benicia, Dixon, Fairfield, Rio vista, Suisun City, Vacaville, Vallejo, and Solano County.



Board members are appointed by their local jurisdictions to serve as representatives on the STA Board of Directors. Each jurisdiction also has staff representatives on the Technical Advisory Committee and the SolanoExpress Intercity Transit Consortium, which act in a technical advisory capacity to the STA Board members and staff.

The STA uses an open and inclusive public involvement process through various committees made up of local elected officials, public works directors, transit operators, and interested citizens in the development of specific policies and transportation plans to improve Solano County's transit systems, roads and freeways, and alternative modes.
