TRANSPORTATION FOR LIVABLE COMMUNITIES Corridor Concept Plan



BACKGROUND

The North Connector Transportation for Livable Communities (TLC) Concept Plan looks to address the multi-modal opportunities along the North Connector corridor and identify improvements to bicycle, pedestrian, and transit facilities. The Concept Plan will examine the North Connector from a corridor-wide perspective, allowing the STA, community, and

partner agencies to create a cohesive vision for the corridor while also presenting unique design elements for each segment.

The following goals and objectives were developed with input from STA, Solano County, and the City of Fairfield:

Develop a unifying but flexible design theme for the corridor



- Define common corridor elements
- Develop uniform streetscape concepts
- Identify suitable locations for gateways

Engage the community in a meaningful dialogue about enhancement opportunities along the North Connector Corridor



- Host community based work shops to discuss design opportunities
- Listen and learn from community feedback
- Incorporate community feedback into design approach

Enhance the multi-modal function of the corridor



- Improve neighborhood bicycle, pedestrian, and transit connections
- Enhance intersections for crossing safety, comfort and convenience
- Develop multi-use pedestrian and bicycle networks
- Identify new local and intercity bus stops and transit centers
- Encourage circulation enhancements in site plans along the corridor
