OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY AWARDS GRANT FOR SR-12 SAFETY CORRIDOR

The California Highway Patrol was notified today that the California Office of Traffic Safety has issued the grant to fund enforcement for the SR-12 safety corridor through Solano County. Although this grant will cover SR-12 from the I-80 junction to I-5, The Solano Area of the California Highway Patrol, in association with the Fairfield Police Department, Suisun City Police Department and Rio Vista Police Department will begin double fine zone enforcement at midnight on January 1, 2008. Enforcement of the double fine zone to the east of Rio Vista will be handled by the South Sacramento and Stockton CHP areas. Base fines for moving violations will double and enhanced enforcement for all police agencies along the Solano County section of the corridor will begin effective on that day. Funding approved for the increased enforcement along with roadway safety improvements including sections of positive median barriers and traffic delineators are a result of efforts by Assemblywoman Lois Wolk's sponsorship of AB112. In addition, a close working, cooperative effort with OTS, CHP, CalTrans and county and city officials have been successful in expediting an enhanced enforcement and roadway improvement effort while waiting for the passage of this bill.
