**Re: Request for Proposal (RFP No. 2012-04) for the Jepson Parkway Project Concept Plan Update**

The Solano Transportation Authority (STA) is issuing a Request for Proposals (RFP) for firms to complete an update to the Jepson Parkway Concept Plan in Solano County. The STA approved the Jepson Parkway Concept Plan in 2000 with a recommendation to pursue the development of the Parkway in order to provide improved local traffic circulation in northern Solano County as well as reduce current and future congestion in the region. Early segments of the Parkway have been completed in Suisun City (Walters Road), Fairfield and Solano County (Peabody Road- Vanden Road-Cement hill Intersection) and Vacaville (Leisure Town Road Interchange). The Concept Plan has served STA very well over the last 10 plus years and it is now time to update the document and provide additional framework as the remaining segments are designed and funded for construction.

Interested organizations are invited to submit six (6) hard copies and one (1) electronic copy (CD or Flash Drive) of your Proposal and a description of how they would fulfill the requirements of the Scope of Work. Responses are to be addressed to Janet Adams, Director of Projects, Solano Transportation Authority, One Harbor Center, Suite 130, Suisun City, CA 94585 no later than 3:00 p.m., **Friday, April 27, 2012.**

The STA has adopted a Local Preference Policy which encourages the hiring of local firms. While there is no adopted goal for this Project, firms are still encouraged to utilize the services of local firms in the preparation of a response to this RFP. The STA has prepared a database of contact information for local firms for convenience purposes only and without guarantees as to the ability of such firms to provide the services. Responses will be reviewed and the proposed project teams will be ranked. At the discretion of STA, the project teams in the top tier of the rankings may be interviewed by a panel made up of STA staff and selected partners.
