## **Travis Air Force Base Employees Meet Solano Commute Challenge**

**SUISUN CITY, CA** – Thirty-eight military and civilian employees from Travis Air Force Base were recognized last week by the Solano Transportation Authority (STA) and Fairfield Mayor Harry Price as part of the 2012 Solano Commute Challenge.

Travis Air Force Base was one of five employers to earn the title “Commute Champion Workplace.” Mayor Price, member of the STA Board, thanked 60<sup>th</sup> Air Mobility Wing/Base Commander Col. Dwight Sones, and Tom Bradley, on-site Commute Challenge Coordinator for their efforts. Sam George was recognized as Travis Air Force Base’s Most Outstanding Commuter for using a commute alternative on 86 workdays.

The sixth annual Solano Commute Challenge was sponsored by the STA, and coordinated by Solano Napa Commuter Information (SNCI) in partnership with large employers and chambers of commerce throughout Solano County. 47 major employers totaling 655 employees participated in the sixth annual Solano Commute Challenge countywide.

The Commute Challenge is a targeted outreach campaign for major Solano County employers to encourage employees to use transit, carpool, vanpool, bike, or walk to work on at least 30 workdays from August through October.
