State Compensation Insurance Fund Employees Meet Solano Commute Challenge

SUISUN CITY, CA – One hundred nine employees from State Compensation Insurance Fund in Vacaville were recognized by Vacaville Mayor Steve Hardy and the Vacaville Chamber of Commerce President/CEO Mark Creffield as part of the 2013 Solano Commute Challenge.

State Fund in Vacaville was one of six employers to earn the title “Commute Champion Workplace.” In addition, State Fund was named “Most Outstanding Workplace” in 2013. Sheila Rebosa was recognized as State Fund’s Most Outstanding Commuter for using a commute alternative on 88 workdays. Mayor Hardy, Chair of the Solano Transportation Authority (STA) Board, thanked Cherry Hozian, State Fund’s onsite coordinator for her efforts.

The seventh annual Solano Commute Challenge was sponsored by the STA. The Commute Challenge is part of the Solano Napa Commuter Information (SNCI) program which partners with large employers and chambers of commerce throughout Solano County. 40 major employers totaling 744 employees participated in this year’s Solano Commute Challenge countywide.

The Commute Challenge is a targeted outreach campaign for major Solano County employers to encourage employees to use transit, carpool, vanpool, bike, or walk to work on at least 30 workdays from August through October.
