


- The STA is responsible for :

  - Setting transportation priorities




# 10 Rio Vista Waterfront

- Rio Vista completed waterfront plan
- STA funded design of Phase I project



# SR12 West, Jameson Canyon

- Caltrans began construction of 1.3 miles of Truck Climbing lane from WB I-80 off ramp to SR12 WB on ramp
- STA took over as lead agency on Jameson Canyon Widening Project design




# Vallejo Baylink Ferry

- Senator Pat Wiggins authored successful legislation transitioning ferry service to WETA
- Solano County's Anthony Intintoli appointed to WETA Board
- BATA/Solano County/STA/City of Vallejo adopted transitional operations funding plan



# 7 North Connector Project

- Approved environmental document and funding agreement
- Adopted North Connector TLC Concept Plan
- 4 miles of new roadway parallel to I-80 from Abernathy to Red Top Road



# 6 Solano Commute Challenge

- **37** registered employers
- **540+** employees registered countywide



The *second annual* **Solano Commute Challenge** encourages using a commute alternative (carpools, vanpools, transit, bikes, or walking) on at least 30 workdays from August 1-October 31, 2008.




*Compared to 2007 statistics:*




- STA adopted Safe Routes to School Plan and established SR2S Program
- STA helped secure nearly **\$2M** in grant funding for Safe Routes to School Projects in first year
- 29 schools in Solano County participate in Safe Routes to School Plan

- \$150,000** FSUSD & Suisun City for education/encouragement
- \$300,000** Dixon, Rio Vista and Vacaville for Pilot Engineering
- \$900,000** Suisun City, SR12 Class I multi-use path
- \$130,000** Vallejo, Stephen Manor Elem. School improvements
- \$116,000** Education/Encouragement
- \$400,000** Education/Encouragement/Engineering



# 2 I-80 Construction: HOV & Rehab

- Construction began on 8.7 miles of High Occupancy Vehicle lanes: Red Top Road to Air Base Parkway; low bid was 45% under estimate



- Caltrans began rehabilitation of 27 miles of pavement from Vallejo to Vacaville *2 years early*

# 1 SR 12 East Safety



CAPIO Statewide Public Safety Program Winner



- Officer David Frank Lamoree Memorial Sign dedicated
- SR 12 Double Fine Zone enforcement implemented
- CHP Enforcement increased through Office of Traffic Safety Grant
- Caltrans made immediate improvements:
  - Median barrier installed
  - Double striped line implemented
  - Radar signs installed
  - Roadway and Shoulder work
