## **Transportation Info Depot at the Suisun-Fairfield Train Station Grand Opening**

SUISUN CITY, CA - Solano Transportation Authority (STA) is pleased to announce the Grand Opening of the Transportation Info Depot. The new customer service facility is located at the Suisun-Fairfield Train Station. The Grand Opening celebration will be held on Mon., Nov. 3 from 6:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., and will include drawings for free transit passes, including Capitol Corridor, SolTrans, BART, FAST and others.

“We’re happy to expand our reach in the dissemination of public transportation information, services and options for local commuters,” said Vallejo Mayor and STA Board Chair Osby Davis. “The Grand Opening of the Transportation Info Depot marks the launch of a new era in public transit services for commuters in and around Solano and Napa Counties.”

The Transportation Info Depot, located at 177 Main Street in Suisun City, will be open to assist the public Monday through Friday from 6:30 a.m. through 2:00 p.m. and provide the following transportation services:

- Transit Information
- FREE Live Transit Trip Planning
- Fastrak Toll Tag Applications
- Clipper Card Sales and reloads
- Mobility Options for Seniors and People with Disabilities
- Regional Transit Connection Discount ID Card Applications
- Personalized Car and Vanpool Match Lists
- Emergency Ride Home Program
- Commute Incentive Programs
- BikeLink Locker Card Sales

The popular Clipper transit fare card rollout in Solano and Napa Counties is Nov. 3. The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) has expanded Clipper to include Napa VINE in Napa County; the SolTrans, Fairfield and Suisun Transit (FAST), and Vacaville City Coach bus systems in Solano County; and San Francisco Bay Ferry’s Vallejo-to-San Francisco route. Clipper also will be accepted for payment on the new Oakland Airport Connector, expected to open later this year.

Clipper is the all-in-one transit card that keeps track of any passes, discount tickets, ride books and cash value that you load onto it, while applying all applicable fares, discounts and transfer rules. This lets you customize your card for your own transit needs. You can purchase Clipper cards at the Transportation Info Depot.
