Project Description:

The CA Dept of Transportation (Caltrans), in cooperation with the Solano Transportation Authority (STA) and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC), is proposing to provide High Occupancy Vehicle/High Occupancy Toll lanes (HOV/HOT or express lanes) in the westbound and eastbound direction of Interstate 80 (I-80). The project would construct approximately 18 miles of express lanes in the I-80 corridor through conversion of existing HOV lanes and highway widening for new express lanes. The general location of the proposed improvements extends along I-80 from PM 10.4 to 30.2, passing through the cities of Fairfield and Vacaville.
