**Mitch Korcycl is Solano County Bike Commuter of the Year
May 12th, 2016 is 22nd Annual Bike to Work Day**

SUISUN CITY, CA **Mitch Korcycl of Vacaville** has been selected as **Solano County's 2016 Bike Commuter of the Year**. Each year, one person is chosen from each of the nine Bay Area counties to receive a Metropolitan Transportation Commission award in recognition of their exemplary commitment to commuting by bicycle as the Bike Commuter of the Year. Mitch works at Genentech Vacaville and bikes to work almost every day. Mitch recently organized monthly bike to work days and participates in Tuesday night rides with his coworkers. He says that people often say "it's too hard to get involved." His response is "just do it!"

Solano Bike to Work Day - May 12th, 2016 - is presented by 511.org and Kaiser Permanente, with promotions organized by Solano Napa Commuter Information, a program of the Solano Transportation Authority (STA). Additional activities include the Team Bike Challenge and 18 Energizer Stations that will be sponsored throughout Solano County.
