Caltrans Initiates Paving on State Route 113 in the City of Dixon

Suisun City, CA –Caltrans is starting construction on the State Route 113 \$800,000 pavement overlay project from Interstate 80 to Vaughn Road starting Sunday night (September 18th). Grind and paving operations will commence the following night. City of Dixon Mayor Jack Batchelor and the Solano Transportation Authority (STA) have been successfully working with Caltrans to expand the scope of the initial project with an additional \$1,000,000 follow up project extending the pavement overlay on SR 113 an additional 1.3 miles to Stratford Ave. in the Summer of 2017.

“Investments on SR113 are necessary for the continued vitality of the City of Dixon, after working with Caltrans on pushing these investments forward, I am pleased to see the work starting”, said the Mayor of Dixon Jack Batchelor. “With Caltrans commitment to funding the additional improvements next summer, our city residents and businesses will drive on an improved and safer SR 113. I am also working with Caltrans and STA to initiate a major pavement rehabilitation project for the entire SR 113 corridor between I-80 and State Route 12 due to the serious pavement deterioration within this corridor.”

Of the 22 mile SR 113 corridor linking SR 12 to I-80, 3 miles of SR 113 traverse through the City of Dixon. An estimated 11,800 daily trips on SR 113 travel through the City of Dixon.
