Benicia Breeze Services

- Flex-route service operates during morning and afternoon commute hours of 5:50am-8:50am and 3:50pm-5:50pm
 - Flex-Route 21 services areas of Rose Drive, Southampton and West Military
 - Flex-Route 22 services the Industrial Park, East Military, Rancho Benicia and Casa DeVilarrasa
- Supplemental Routes 15 and 17



Benicia Breeze Services Cont...

- Dial-A-Ride service operated between the hours of 8:50am and 3:50pm, and again between 5:50pm and 8:20pm.
- Dial-A-Ride service operated all day Saturday
- Open to all riders within city limits
- Same day scheduling only
- Subscription service available





Benicia Breeze Services Continued...

- **ADA Paratransit Plus Service** – paratransit service that is above and beyond legally required paratransit service.
- Service available in town as well as transfer availability to Vallejo and Contra Costa County.
- Door to Door
- Operates Monday-Friday 6:00am-8:30pm with a gap in service from 4:00pm-6:30pm due to limited resources

Additional Services:

- Shuttle service via Route 76 to DVC and Sun Valley Mall – 5 times a day

Senior/Disabled Services

- **Medical Shuttle** servicing Kaiser and Sutter Solano Hospitals on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays
- **Shopping Shuttle** offered on Wednesdays to Sun Valley Mall
 - Shuttle stops focus on Senior Center, Rancho Benicia, and Casa De Vilarrasa
- **Taxi scrip** 50/50 program – Open to Seniors at age 65 and persons with disabilities

Current Outlook

- Service is still being monitored and tracked since October 6, 2008 restructure
- Current ridership: (Fiscal Year 08-09) **71,942**
- Paratransit: **3,079**
- 10% Loss of TDA Funding
- New bus shelters in 2010
